FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

IQAC organized RUSA supported webinar on faculty development session - “**Launching Add on courses: Key components**” on **10th July 2021** at 3:30 pm for the In-house faculty. **Dr. Roshan D’Souza** delivered a detailed session on how to launch add-on courses, design and structure of the course and key components. 

Orientation programme for FYJC students





PRIZE DISTRIBUTION & DEGREE CONFERRING CEREMONY FOR THE 2019-2020 BATCH






