

Minutes of the 10th B. O. S. Meeting held on 6th June, 2023

The **10th** online BOS Meeting of the Department of Hindi was held on 6th June 2023 at 5.00 pm on the Zoom platform. Our VC Nominee Dr. Satyawati Chaubey, two Subject Experts Dr. Ravindra Katyayan and Dr. Dinesh Pathak, our Sophia alumna Dr. Tabassum Khan and Industry Expert Mr. Sunder Chand Thakur along with the host team, Chairperson – Dr. Vaishali Pachunde, Dept. member – Dr. Smriti Singh and Ms. Priyanka Chauhan attended the meeting.

Everyone including Dr. Vaishali Pachunde congratulated Dr. Ravindra Katyayan on the release of his story “Pani Bai”.

- Dr. Vaishali welcomed everyone and after obtaining permission from VC nominee Dr. Chaubey, went over the agenda points one by one. She started with reading the minutes of the previous meeting (9th BOS meeting) which was held on 3rd October, 2022. These minutes were approved by all the members.
- Dr. Vaishali then took up FYBA 2023 SEM I Syllabus under NEP 2020 and updated the Members about the format of (DSC) Hindi Major , Minor, VSC, AEC, VEC, OE AND SEC pattern and discussed credit points for FYBA 2023 courses.
- There was a query from Dr. Chaubey about the AEC credit points. Dr. Vaishali explained that as per our College guidelines Hindi Department asked to keep AEC course for 1 credit equals to 1 lecture per week. Dr. Chaubey suggested Re-Assess AEC Credit Course Points and to get confirmation about SEC course from College that SEC Course is Minor or the Major subject.
- Dr. Vaishali After explaining the course points, took up exam related points and updated the members about I.A. (Internal Assessment) status of DSC, AEC, VSC and SEC Courses. For SEC,VSC, AEC and VEC courses will have IA only.
- After that Dr. Vaishali shared information about the department's DSE courses of the year 2023. She shared the syllabus of DSE with the Members. The syllabus will include selected stories from “Pratinidhi Kahaniyan” and some different genres of Hindi literature from the book “Anya Gadya Vividha”. All the group members suggested that we keep some new stories in the syllabus.
- Dr. Vaishali shared information about the department's Minor course of the year 2023. She shared the syllabus of FYBA Minor course. It will include Hindi stories and a grammar portion, all the members suggested to keep new stories. It is also suggested to

keep simple grammar. All the members have given their consent for the new stories and grammar to be added in the syllabus.

- Dr. Vaishali shared information about VSC courses of the department for the year 2023. The course was named “Creative Writing”, where the art of writing could encourage students to take interest in Hindi amongst all the students. All the members gave approval for the course.
- Dr. Vaishali told all the members about the syllabus of the SEC course, The Course is designed in such a way that non-Hindi students can increase their Hindi language skills, All the members asked to connect the stories with writing and reading skills. They suggested including Hindi grammar. Dr. Satyavati Choubey suggested for writing skill add translation, screenplay, script writing, and advertising. Dr. Ravindra Katyayan Sir suggested a workshop.
- Dr. Vaishali shared information about SEM -II DSC, Minor, AEC, VSC AND SEC courses of the department for the year 2023-2024 While sharing the experience of taking students on field trips, Dr. Vaishali suggested keeping field trips on subject related topics. All the members agreed on that and also suggested keep new subjects.
- For VSC SEM-II, अनुवाद कला has been kept and it has been suggested to reduce some topics from the first unit to get it completed in the given lectures for that. It is said to keep only 4 points in it. Suggested to introduce तकनीकी शब्दावली and to remove the अनुवाद की परम्परा and keep paragraphs for translation from English to Hindi.
- Dr. Dinesh Pathak suggested to add new chapters for the syllabus and also suggested some novels such as शकुन्तिका, सपनों की होम डिलीवरी, रविंद्र कालिया की ABCD Novel.
- Dr. Sundar Chand Thakur suggested choosing new stories in the syllabus.
- No change was proposed in the syllabus of SY and TY Sem III and V for this year.
- As per the Point no. 5 of Agenda Dr. Vaishali asked permission to authorise the chairperson, BOS to modify/ tweak the Syllabus (if needed) all the members have given the permission.
- At the end of the discussion Dr. Vaishali gave a vote of thanks and the meeting came to an end at 6.00 pm.

The 9th online BOS Meeting of the Department of Hindi was held on 3rd October 2022 at 6 pm on the Zoom platform. Our VC Nominee Dr. Satyawati Chaubey, Two Subject Experts Dr. Ravindra Katayyan and Dr. Dinesh Pathak, our Sophia alumna Dr. Tabassum Khan and Industry Expert Mr. Sunder Chand Thakur along with the host team attended the meeting.

Everyone including Dr. Sethi congratulated Mr. Thakur on the release of his publication 'सुख से जीने'.

- Dr. Sethi welcomed everyone and after obtaining permission from VC nominee Dr. Chaubey, went over the agenda points one by one. She started with reading the minutes of the previous meeting (8th BOS meeting) which was held on 7th May, 2022. These minutes were approved by all the members.
- She then took up exam related points and updated the members about IA (Internal Assessment) status of all the three degree classes. The IA and SEE carry 50:50 (equal) marks. For IA marks, two best scores from 3 IA activities are chosen, carrying 25 marks each. The first two IAs have a good mix of objective and descriptive segments while the third is entirely descriptive in format. Dr. Sethi displayed an IA question paper (Paper 5) on her screen to the members. She also explained the SEE exam pattern which was supposed to be fully descriptive having four questions of 14+12+12+12 with options and which amounted to a total of 50 marks. She informed the members that 6th October was the starting date for TY and SY exams and that the FY exams will be held in December.
- There was a query from Dr. Chaubey about the RTC type questions in papers. Dr. Sethi explained that all those papers which were based on textual studies have Reference to Context type questions in the paper.
