Module II: ‘Socio-Economic Reforms under Nehru; Lal Bahadur Shastri and the rise of Indira Gandhi; Non- Aligned Movement and Foreign Policy’ was changed to ‘Socio-Economic Reforms; Foreign Policy’

Module V changed from Growth of Communalism, Regionalism and Separatist Movements; Reservation Policy; Empowerment of Women' to 'Communalism; Regionalism; Separatist Movements; Dalit Movement; Women's Movements'

Paper VI

Module I revised from 'Methods of Exploration, Excavation and Dating Antiquities' to 'Dating Methods'

Paper VII

Module III: 'deleted in the Karnatak'

Module V replaced 'and Cultural Developments' with 'Art and Architecture'

Module V deleted 'of the Marathas'

Module IV deleted 'Post-Ambedkar Dalit Movement' as it is similar to the topic in Paper V.

Paper VIII

Module III deleted 'and' and added 'South America'

Module IV shifted 'Indigenous Peoples' Movements' from Module V.

Module V deleted 'Indigenous Peoples' Movements'; added 'Global Terrorism; Human Rights'

Paper IX

Module IX-added 'Regional Alliances' to title and subtopics.
