- **Prevent Plagiarism:** Implement proactive measures, such as plagiarism detection software and educational initiatives, to deter and prevent instances of plagiarism before they occur.
- **Enforce Consequences:** Define procedures and consequences for addressing confirmed cases of plagiarism, ensuring that appropriate disciplinary actions are taken to uphold academic integrity and maintain the credibility of our institution's academic standards.

POLICY DETAILS

Sophia College uses "Turnitin Similarity Checker" as the in-house plagiarism detection software. This is to ensure that documents such as thesis, dissertation, reports, publications etc are free of plagiarism at the time of their submission. It is mandatory to submit the report of plagiarism check, as appropriate. The Sophia College Research policy on plagiarism is rigid and it mandates a resubmission of the entire work if established as a plagiarized submission.

As an autonomous college affiliated to university of Mumbai, the institution would continue with the plagiarism policy adopted by the university of Mumbai with reference to the affixed circular and revisions thereof with due respect to decisions and regulations implemented by the research and development cell of the college.
