Please follow the guidelines outlined in the journal's Author Guidelines while preparing your research paper submission.

Submission Requirements

All submissions are to be sent to submissions.beyondmargins@gmail.com in the following format:

Abstract of the manuscript (in 150 words):

Submissions from one or more authors are accepted as long as all information about the co-authors is provided accurately.

Kindly ensure that the submission is original and does not replicate any previously published work, including your own. Work that does not qualify our plagiarism check will not be shortlisted. The manuscript should not be submitted for review elsewhere while under consideration at Beyond Margins.

The deadline for sending us your submission is the **31st October, 2024**. No submissions would be accepted after this date.



Guidelines: Research Papers

- **Word limit:** between 3000 to 6000 words. (Excluding abstract and citations)
 - Abstract word limit - 150 words
 - Ensure that the document is written in **UK English**.
- **Format:**
 - *Font* - Times New Roman,
 - *Font Size* - 12,
 - *Line Spacing* - 1.5
- **Layout:** A4 (or US letter) with 1"/2.5 cm margins (select "normal" in Word).
 - The paper must be submitted in an **editable Word document**.
 - Apart from embedding tables or graphs in the Word document, they are to be submitted separately in an editable Excel spreadsheet.
- **Layout (contd.):**
 - Supply images and charts **separately (in .jpg format)**. Credits, as well as links to them, are needed.
 - No more than three levels of headings should be used.
- **Currency format:** INR, USD, KRW, etc.
- **Dates:** 9th/15th century | 1st April, 1922.
- **Transliterated words** are to be italicised.
- **Titles** of books, movies, songs, and television programmes are to be put in single inverted commas.
- **Special Characters:**
 - Please do not copy-and-paste symbols from the internet or other PDF documents, as this might cause problems during typesetting.
 - In Word, from the "Insert" tab, go to "Symbol" and select a Unicode character.
 - While using special characters, please supply us with a PDF of your paper indicating how the text should appear.

Guidelines: Articles

1. What do we mean by articles?

Articles refer to original articles relevant to the field of Economics and Finance that will be published in the Beyond Margin Journal. These include op-eds, essays and review articles. Note that these articles are not research paper submissions.

2. Writing guidelines:

- The word limit of your article should be **no less than 700 and no more than 1000 words**. Attach your article to the mail as a word document **only**. No
- more than two levels of headings should be used. Kindly attach tables and
- figures separately to the mail if they accompany your article (in .jpg format).
- Credits to your picture attachments are required, along with links to the same. All work submitted has to be original and previously unpublished.

Journal Guidelines

Referencing

For both our articles and research papers, We use the APA (7th edition) style of referencing, without any accompanying footnotes/endnotes.

In-text Citations:

- All quotations are to be inserted within double inverted commas and cited in the format suggested below:
 - “I hope she’ll be a fool -- that’s the best thing a girl can be in this world, a beautiful little fool.” (Fitzgerald, 1925).
- While paraphrasing include a full in-text citation with the author name and page number/s.
- When citing a report that does not have a specific author but was written by an organisation, institute, or group, the name of the organisation, institute, or group is used instead of the author’s name. For instance, (Kelkar Committee, 2018) or (Reserve Bank of India, 2021).

Bibliography:

An exhaustive list of sources is compulsory.

Basic Format: Author Last Name, First Name, Middle Name or Initial. *Title of Longer Work* or “Title of Shorter Work”. Publisher, Year. URL or DOI



We would require detailed and accurate documentation of how any empirical, experimental, or numerical data was collected to reproduce your findings. You will be asked to indicate your compliance to the same. Please note that there will be **no monetary remuneration** for your submission.
