

- 2. To pass the minutes of the previous BOS Meeting held on OCTOBER 10, 2022:

The minutes of previous BOS Meeting which was held on OCTOBER 10, 2022 was passed by all the present BOS members.

- 3. Opening remarks by the Department of Information Technology
- 4. To scrutinize the Assessment pattern
 - All the examinations will be conducted in the offline mode
 - Exam pattern IA (40Marks) + SEE (60 Marks) + Practical (50Marks) for SY and TY 2023-24
 - IA (40 Marks) = 1 Test (20 Marks) + 1 Assignment/ PPT/ Project (16 Marks) (depends on the nature of the paper) + Active class Participation (4 Marks)
 - Suggestion from the BOS regarding paper pattern is to have answers in one sentence for 10 Marks in the SEE paper and 50 Marks subjective questions for (SY and TY).
 - External Examiners will be called for Semester 5, T.Y practical examination.
- 5. Discussion of F.Y syllabus under NEP 2020
 - The BOS members had a detailed discussion with the credits systems for the FY NEP
 2023 2024 batch
 - SEM I 22 credits + SEM II 22 credits = Total of 44 Credits for the First year

- Mr. Ajay Barve suggested Vedic Maths/ History of evolution of IT sector in the India to be introduced as a subject for Indian Knowledge System (IKS) in Semester I.
- After the brief discussion on the credit system and the subjects and syllabi taken under separate heads was approved by the BOS members during the meeting.
