- 2. To pass the minutes of the previous BOS Meeting held on APRIL 16, 2022:


The minutes of previous BOS Meeting which was held on APRIL 16, 2022 was passed by all the present BOS members.

3. Opening remarks by the Department of Information Technology:

In the academic year 2022, we have conducted one credit Intermediate add-on course (30 hours) for our students on "Ethical Hacking" and for the academic year 2022 in the month of November we would continue with the same course and conduct an additional one credit Foundation add-on course (30 hours) on "Ethical Hacking" and we are also conducting add-on course on advanced excel (30 hours). Both foundation and intermediate add on course contents on "Ethical Hacking" were discussed briefly and approved by the BOS members. Suggestions were given on conducting add-on courses on cloud computing etc. but after upgrading the infrastructure.

- 4. Discussion of F.Y syllabus

- 5. To scrutinize the Assessment pattern
 - All the examinations will be conducted in the offline mode
 - Exam pattern IA (50Marks) + SEE (50 Marks) + Practical (50Marks)
 - IA = 1 Test + 1 Assignment + 1 PPT/ Project (depends on the nature of the paper)
 - Paper pattern for the SEE for all the three years will be subjective questions.
 - BOS agreed to the suggestion of 10Marks to be given for journal but with proper evaluation of journal content and suggested to plan the evaluation pattern of journals accordingly
 - No moderation will be done for all the three years.
