SOPHIA COLLEGE (Autonomous) Department of Hindi Minutes of the 11th B. O. S. Meeting Held on 18th October, 2023

The **11th** online BOS Meeting of the Department of Hindi was held on 18th October 2023 at 6.00 pm on the Zoom platform. Our VC Nominee Dr. Satyawati Chaubey, two Subject Experts Dr. Ravindra Katyayan and Dr. Dinesh Pathak, our Sophia alumna Dr. Tabassum Khan and Industry Expert Mr. Sunder Chand Thakur along with the host team, Chairperson – Dr. Vaishali Pachunde, Dept. member – Dr. Smriti Singh and Ms. Priyanka Chauhan attended the meeting.

- Dr. Vaishali welcomed everyone and after obtaining permission from VC nominee Dr. Satyawati Chaubey, went over the agenda points one by one. She started with reading the minutes of the previous meeting (10th B.O.S. meeting) which was held on 6th June, 2023. These minutes were approved by all the members.
- Dr. Vaishali then took up FYBA 2023 SEM II Syllabus under NEP 2020 and updated the Members about the syllabus of SEM II of (DSC) Hindi Major, (DSE) Hindi Minor, VSC and common courses AEC, VEC, OE AND SEC. She appraised the members that in SEM II only FYBA Major, Minor and VSC, AEC course syllabus will change and other common courses syllabus will remain as per SEM I. She also discussed the credit points for FYBA SEM II 2023 Courses. FYBA Major and Minor are of 4 credits, AEC is for 1 credit and all other Common courses are of 2 credits.
- After that Dr. Vaishali shared information about the department's Hindi Major Courses of the FYBA SEM II, 2023. She shared the syllabus with the Members. The syllabus will include the selected Novel "Pachpan Khambe lal Diware" and the book "Gadya Vividha- Bhag-2" which includes different genres of Hindi literature. V.C. nominee and all the B. O. S. members approved the syllabus.
- Dr. Vaishali shared information about the FYBA Hindi Minor course of the SEM II 2023. It will include Hindi poems and a grammar portion (Aadhunik Kavya evam Hindi Bhasha) all the members approved the syllabus.

- Dr. Vaishali shared information about the VSC course of the FYBA SEM II 2023. The course is known as "Anuvad kala", it includes the art of translation which will encourage the students to take interest in translation work and choose it as a career.
- Dr. Vaishali appraised all the members about the syllabus of the SEC course i.e. "Hindi Bhasha Kaushal", The Course is introduced in SEM I which will continue in SEM II for new students. It is designed in such a way that non-Hindi students can increase their Hindi language skills.
- Dr. Vaishali appraised all the members about the OE course, the title of the course is "Natya Evam Rangmanch Kala" in reference to the play "Madhavi" written by Bhishma Sahni has been included in this course in SEM I. For this course C.A assignment, Dr. Satyawati Chaubey suggested a poster presentation. All approved the same.
- Dr. Vaishali appraised all the members about the VEC course and the title of the course is 'Human Values in Hindi Literature'. Through it moral qualities are developed within the students and they become sensitive towards humanity. From the book 'Sahitya Saurabh' some stories and poems have been included in this course. Dr. Vaishali expressed her opinion to also keep the couplets and verses from the medieval poets like Saint Kabir, Rahim, Tulsi and Kavi Vrind to which Dr. Satyawati Choubey completely agreed but since the syllabus already taught in SEM I and for the FYBA students Dr. Ravindra expressed his intention that the simple stories and poems kept is totally good.
- Dr. Vaishali appraised all the members about the AEC course and the title of the course is "Samkaleen Mahila Kahanikar". This includes Stories written by Hindi renowned female writers that were kept so that students would be aware of the problems related to women's and their rights in the society. These stories are taken from the book 'Mahila: Kahani Aur Kavita'. All the members approved the syllabus.
- To enable students of FYBA to choose their courses, Dr. Ravindra suggested taking an orientation program.
- Dr. Vaishali After explaining the course points, took up exam related points and updated the members the assessment pattern i.e. 50-50 for FYBA Major, Minor, SYBA and TYBA Courses. There will be C.A. (Continuous Assessment) for 50 marks. 25 marks each (test and assignment) and S.A. (Summative Assessment) for 50 marks at the end of each SEM for FYBA Major, Minor, SYBA and TYBA. For SEC, VSC, AEC, OE, and VEC common courses will have 2 C.A for 50 marks which includes 20 marks each (test and assignment) and 10 marks for class participation and no S.A. for Common Courses.



In SEM I Dr. Vaishali has taken FY Major and Minor, SY and TY Students to the High Court interpleader and Translator Office at Dhobi Talao, Mumbai. - No change was proposed in the syllabus of SY and TY SEM IV and VI for this year.
- Dr. Vaishali asked permission to authorize the chairperson, BOS to modify/ tweak the Syllabus (if needed) all the members have given the permission.
- At the end of the discussion Dr. Vaishali gave a vote of thanks and the meeting came to an end at 7.00 pm.
