Minutes of the 13th B.O.S. Meeting held on 27th September, 2024

Sophia College for Women (Empowered Autonomous)

The **13th** online BOS Meeting of the Department of Hindi was held on 27 September 2024 at 12.30 pm on the Zoom platform. Our VC Nominee Dr. Satyawati Chaubey, two Subject Experts Dr. Ravindra Katyayan and Dr. Dinesh Pathak, our Sophia alumna Dr. Tabassum Khan and Industry Expert Mr. Sunder Chand Thakur along with the host team, Chairperson – Dr. Vaishali Pachunde, Dept. member – Dr. Smriti Singh and Ms. Priyanka Chauhan attended the meeting.

- Dr. Vaishali welcomed everyone and after obtaining permission from VC nominee, Dr. Satyawati Chaubey, went over the agenda points one by one. She started with reading the minutes of the previous meeting (12th BOS meeting) which was held on 10th April 2024. These minutes were approved by all the members.
- Dr. Vaishali then presented again SYBA 2023 SEM III AND IV Syllabus in compliance with NEP 2020 and updated the Members about the syllabus of sem III of (DSC) Hindi Major 3 and 4, (DSE) Hindi Minor 3, VSC and common courses AEC and SEC. She also discussed the credit points for SYBA SEM III and IV 2024 Course i.e. SYBA Major 3 and 4 and Minor 3 are of 4 credits, AEC is for 1 credit and VSC and SEC Common courses are of 2 credits.
- Members were informed about the changes made in SYBA sem III syllabus in compliance with the NEP 2020 and their suggestions were taken for SYBA sem III Major 3 i.e. in ‘Medieval and Modern Poems’ and also taken permission from them to reduce some paragraphs of poetry Rashmirathi i.e. from two cantos (सर्ग) of Rashmirathi so that the students can understand it

better. Dr. Satywati Choubey asked to keep only one canto (सर्ग) so that the students could read that canto well and all the members agreed.

- In the sem III SYBA Major 4 प्रयोजनमूलक हिंदी curriculum, a discussion was held on the practical applications of 'Advertisement Writing' under Functional Hindi. During the discussion, Mr. Sunderchand Thakur suggested including Artificial Intelligence (AI) in the curriculum so that Hindi students can become familiar with that technology. Dr. Chaubey proposed incorporating it in the semester IV Mass Communication course, where it could be covered under New Media. Additionally, Dr. Vaishali suggested adding this topic to the SEC course under Computer and Hindi, which was unanimously agreed upon by all the BOS members.
- Dr. Vaishali informed all members about the workshop organized for advertisement writing. Experts from the film and media industry were invited to this workshop, so that students could gain detailed knowledge about the practical application and strategies of advertisement writing.
- Dr. Vaishali informed all the members about the inclusion of the play "Bakri" and two one act plays namely 'sukhi dali' and 'stree ka hridya' in the SYBA semester IV Minor 4 curriculum. All members unanimously agreed to the proposal of adding this play to the syllabus.
- After the conclusion of the curriculum, Dr. Vaishali discussed the add-on course, which traditionally included "Sara Hindi Skilled course" every year. However, due to non-adjustment of time with Hindustani Prachar Sabha this year, the course could not be offered in SEM I and III. Nevertheless, she provided information about including it in the SYBA Semester IV Co-Curriculum Course for 2 credits. Dr. Chaubey also suggested that permission could be obtained from the Hindustani Prachar Sabha to initiate this course. Additionally, Dr. Vaishali proposed offering "Sara Hindi Skilled Course" as

Co Curricular course for FYBA semester II students in compliance with NEP 2020, which all members agreed upon.

- Dr. Vaishali provided information about the Co Curricular course on 'DOCUMENTARY AND SHORT FILM MAKING' offered in SYBA semester III, which is a 30-hours, 2-credit course. This course was established with the assistance of 'Indian Documentary Producers' Association' and it included a total of 44 students from all subjects of SYBA. The feedback from the students was excellent. The assessment of the students in this course was conducted through assignments.
- Dr. Vaishali then appraised the members about the field project titled as 'Challenges and Opportunities in Modern Drama and Story' given to SYBA Major students for 2 credits for sem III in compliance with NEP 2020.
- A field trip was organized under RUSA, in which a total 17 students from TYBA and SYBA were taken to the Samadhi of Sant Dnyaneshwar and the Samadhi of Sant Tukaram at Dehu Alandi. The objective of this field trip was to enable students to get information about saint literature related to the Bhaktikal period. All the members agreed to this event.
- Dr. Vaishali then appraised the BOS Members that in SEM II, IV and VI she will be planning to take FY Major and Minor, SY and TYBA Students of the Hindi Department to the High Court Chief Interpleader and Translator Office at Dhobi Talao, Mumbai, films Division Office at Peddar Road, and also to Hindustani Prachar Sabha Library, Charni Road and Hindi Elocution competition with the support of Hindustani Prachar Sabha in the college.
- Dr. Vaishali asked permission to authorize the chairperson, BOS to modify/ tweak the Syllabus (if needed) all the members have given the permission.
- At the end of the discussion Dr. Vaishali gave a vote of thanks and the meeting came to an end at 1.30 pm.

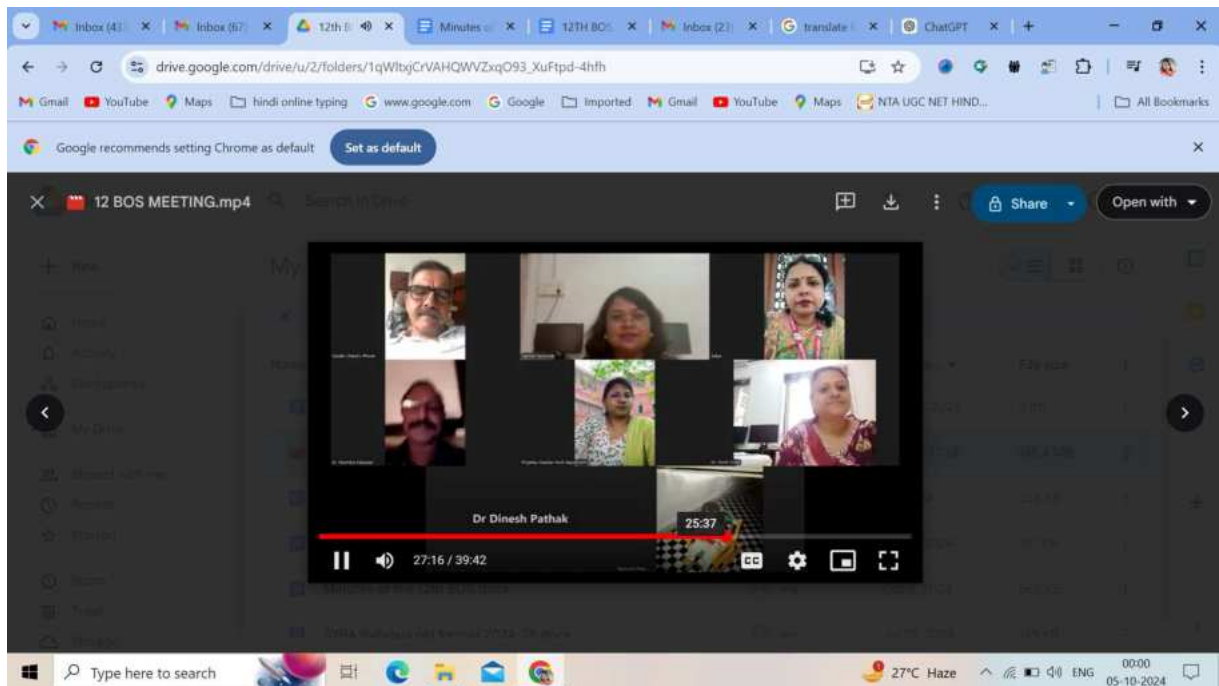
- Permission was obtained from all board members to digitally sign the soft copy of the syllabus and the minutes, to which everyone agreed.

1. The proposed Co-Curricular Course 'DOCUMENTARY AND SHORT FILM MAKING' for SYBA students for Semester III, in compliance with NEP 2020, is hereby accepted and passed by all BOS Members present at this meeting. proposed and seconded by all the BOS members. Course started from 5th August, 2024 and ended on 15th September, 2024. Total 44 students from SYBA registered and completed the Course.
2. The proposed Field Project on 'Challenges and Opportunities in the Modern Drama and Story' for SYBA Major Students for Semester III, in compliance with NEP 2020, is hereby accepted and passed by all BOS members present at this meeting proposed and seconded by all the BOS members.
