The third meeting of the Board of Studies (Hindi, Sophia College) was held on 11th September 2019 (AY 2019-2020), in which the V.C. nominee, Dr. Manpreet Kaur, Subject Expert Shri Dinesh Pathak & Dr. Ravindra Katyayan, Industry Representative Shri Sundarchand Thakur and PG Alumna Mrs. Tabassum Khan along with the faculty members of the Department of Hindi were present. The meeting was chaired by Dr. Sumanika Sethi, Head of Hindi Department. Deliberations as per the agenda items of the meeting are as follows:


1. The minutes of the 2nd BoS meeting were placed before the members and they confirmed the same.
2. After signing the minutes of the 2nd BoS, the discussion centred on the FYBA class. The VC nominee Dr. Manpreet Kaur suggested that the story *Antim Bayan* be withdrawn from the syllabus of compulsory Hindi. The other members also suggested different formats for objective type questions and grammar. There was a discussion about some poems and their possible removal from the syllabus.
3. After FYBA there were some suggestions for Paper III i.e. Functional Hindi. Dr. Manpreet Kaur insisted on taking the students to banks or railways offices to get acquainted with technical terminology, to make them write film reviews and blogs. Members also suggested to give assignments on other subjects related to Functional Hindi.
4. For TYBA no new change was proposed but there was a discussion on Paper VI i.e. Information Technology and Hindi, about the relevance of its theory aspect.
5. Dr. Sethi informed the BoS members about the student feedback regarding the changed texts. In FYBA (Hindi AM) students liked the text *Pachpan Khambhe Lal Divaren* very

much. This proved to be a good initiation for them into the literary world. In SYBA, the novel *Daur* (by *Mamta Kalia*) was also well received by our students. The two plays also proved to be a good upgradation. One was *Ek aur Dronacharya* by *Shankar Shesh* and *Adhe Adhure* by *Mohan Rakesh*.

6. Dr. Sethi informed the BoS members about the two add-on courses she had planned to introduce.
