Agenda :

1. Discuss and approve the syllabus for S.Y.B.A. Economics class for semester III to be implemented from the academic year 2019-20 (For Eco-P-II, P-III & Applied component paper - Investment Analysis)
2. Inform the members of the BOS about the paper pattern, paper setters and examiners for all papers.

Minutes :

Prof. Ghosh suggested a book by Avinash Dixit for Mathematics paper for T.Y.B.A. class. He ~~also~~ approved topics listed in Eco-P-II & P-III to be implemented from the academic year 2019-20. He also approved paper on Investment Analysis for semester III. He suggested topics for semester IV. He suggested structured lecture method to cover topics from Macroeconomics. He suggested that topics like LPP & forecasting in Econometrics paper can be replaced by some other relevant topics. He suggested for Eco-P-II Macroeconomics division: ~~use~~ of modules in the following order -

1. Money, 2. Financial Sector, 3. Government Sector

Prof. Hataksh suggested reorganising microeconomics P-II for. He suggested ~~Hal Varian~~ a book by Hal Varian. Students needs to be given one reference book as text. eg. Mankiw & L. Ahuja can be used as reference. Prof. Hataksh suggested field trip to nearby tribal areas. One of the field visit to Hirve Bazas. Students can be deployed as interns in

Richa Tripathi suggested some approaches to analyse topics. She suggested trying to relate to student's day to day experiences. CCIL & debt market needs to be introduced in modules of Investment Analysis Paper. For Maths & Stats paper at T.Y. BA level prof. Halebkar approved that this paper will have total 4 modules (2 maths & 3 maths) & paper pattern for this paper will be 5 questions of 15 marks each.
