

## Minutes of the 13<sup>th</sup> BOS meeting held on 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2024

- The meeting of the Board of Studies was held on 23<sup>rd</sup> September, 2024 at 5 pm online via zoom.
- The Head of the Department Dr. P. Shetty welcomed all the members.
- Ms. Tanaz Asha read the minutes of the last BOS meeting which was held on 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2024.
- The syllabus of FYBSc Semester I and II (2+2 pattern) and SYBSc Semester IV, minor and SEC course were presented.
- Dr. Sirisha Murthy explained about the FP and co-curricular courses of SYBSc Semester III to the BOS members which are as follows:
  - 1) Field Project – DRUG AND WATER QUALITY: SAMPLING AND TESTING
  - 2) Co-curricular Course: “POSITIVE HEALTH IN WOMEN”- 2 credits
- Dr. Sirisha Murthy presented SYBSc minor syllabus wherein she mentioned the DSC I of semester III was already ratified in the last BOS meeting. Furthermore, she also informed that the department made some changes to the semester IV syllabus. Earlier there were 2 units of organic chemistry but now it consists of 1 unit of Organic chemistry, 1 unit of Inorganic chemistry, and 1 unit of Analytical chemistry. She further informed that Unit 1 and Unit 2 of DSC II were ratified and Unit 3- Quantitative Method of Analysis is newly introduced.
- Prof. Namboothiri suggested to include the concept of aromaticity and spectroscopic methods such as NMR and mass spectrometry in the SYBSc minor syllabus of semester IV.
- SEC semester IV syllabus was presented by Dr. Prabha Shetty. She informed to the BOS members that the VSC semester III syllabus was already ratified in the last BOS meeting and also explained the continuous assessment pattern of SEC which is as follows:


Experiment -20 Marks
