The chairperson of the BoS, Dr. Perpetua Miranda, welcomed the BoS members and the agenda of the meeting was stated.

- a. The Minutes of the previous meeting were read out by Dr. Perpetua Miranda. The Minutes were proposed by Dr. Ranu Jain and seconded by Dr Shanti Seshadri
- b. Dr. P. Miranda informed the panel that the suggestions given by the BOS members with regard to the FYBA, SYBA and TYBA Sociology syllabi were incorporated in the current Semester.

### **a. The presentation of the FYBA Sociology Paper I syllabus was done**

The syllabi for semesters I and II were read and approved as it is.

### **b. The presentation of the SYBA Sociology Syllabi for Papers II and III was done, and some points made during the presentation were :**

The syllabi of Paper II for Semesters III and IV were read and approved as it is.

The syllabi of Paper III for Semesters III and IV were read and approved as it is.

### **c. The presentation of the TYBA Sociology Syllabi for Papers IV, V and VI was done, and some points made during the presentation were :**

The syllabi of Paper IV for Semesters V and VI were read and approved as it is.

The syllabi of Paper VA for Semesters V and VI were read and approved as it is.

The syllabi of Paper VB for Semesters V and VI were read and approved as it is.

The syllabi of Paper VI for Semesters V and VI were read and approved as it is.

### **d. The presentation of the TYBA Sociology Syllabi for Papers VII, VIII and IX was done and some points made during the presentation were :**

1. Paper VII, the syllabi for semesters V and VI were read and approved as it is.

2. In Paper VIII, Sem VI, Unit III it was suggested to replace LGBTQ+ and Differently abled groups with Senior citizens(Elderly), and Refugees in the section of Marginalized groups.

3. For Paper VIII it was suggested by Bos members to add a new objective to the paper i.e To comprehend citizenship, marginality and social exclusion.

4. For Paper VIII, Sem VI, 'Intersectional Analysis of Social exclusion' as title for Paper VIII, Semester VI Unit 1 was suggested.

5. For Unit 2, Dr. MT Joseph suggested to focus on Ideological formations. Dr. Ranu Jain and Dr. MT Joseph suggested titles for Unit 2 such as : i) Perspectives on Resistance ii) Ideologies of Resistance. All Bos members agreed upon 'Ideologies of Resistance' as a more suitable and appropriate title for Unit 2. As part of Unit 2(B) it was suggested to add Emancipation with alternative nomenclatures like Empowerment, Development, Enlightenment. It was agreed upon to incorporate Emancipation under 2(B).

6. Paper VIII, Sem VI, was discussed at length, the revisions, suggestions and changes in nomenclature were incorporated.

7. Paper IX Semesters V and VI syllabi were discussed and accepted as it is.
