The Chairperson of the BoS, Dr. Anagha Tendulkar began the session by welcoming the members. New member of the Department, Ms. Tresa Francis was also introduced to the Board.

I.

Dr. Anagha spoke about the conduct of the credit course on social research methods. 45 students enrolled for the course, inhouse and non-sophia masters students.

Inaugural session on 25th August 2021 and the keynote speaker was Dr. Zubin Mulla from TISS. The next sessions were conducted by Dr. Anagha tendulkar, Dr Rajula shah and Dr. Ivan John. Students had to attend a special session on research paper presentation by KC College

students of Certificate Programme for Commerce and Arts Batch VII. Subject experts on each topic will be called for the remaining topics. So far, the course is well received by the students.

II. MA gender studies review.

Ms Lata Pujari presented a brief overview of the conduct of the MA programme, highlighting the need to involve the students into community sensitization and engagement projects. Dr Vibhuti agreed to the point put forth by Ms Lata. Dr Ranu jain suggested adding women's access to education, rural development and women as well as participation of women in the informal sector. The suggestions were discussed at length. Ms Lata Pujari pointed out that these subtopics exist in different frames of syllabi at the MA level.

The possibilities of topics for project work were discussed. All the BOS members contributed to the discussion and an exhaustive list of topics was arrived at the end of the discussion.
