

Results of First Year (FY) UG and Second Year (SY) UG Examination of March 2020

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I. University Circulars

II. CALCULATION OF MARKS, AS PER THE UNIVERSITY CIRCULARS, FOR THE SEMESTER FOR WHICH EXAMS COULD NOT BE CONDUCTED DUE TO THE PANDEMIC

The **marks** out of 100 for **every course (paper)** in the corresponding even semester (2nd for FY, 4th for SY and 2nd for PG-1) will be calculated as a **sum of two components** namely:

- (1) Current (Even) Semester Internal Assessment Marks (IA)
- (2) Previous (Odd) Semester Average Marks (PSA)

Option A (FY AND SY BA, BSc, BSc.IT): In the case where IA:SEE is 25:75 format

1. Current (Even) Semester Internal Assessment Marks (IA)

For any course (paper) the even semester IA marks out of 25 is to be added to the Previous (Odd) Semester Average Marks (PSA) to obtain SEE for the course (paper) for which exams could not be held.

e.g. The student has obtained the IA Marks 20 /25.

2. How to calculate Previous (Odd) Semester Average Marks (PSA)

The average of marks of all the subjects (theory and practical) obtained by a student in the previous **odd** semester will be calculated. This will be the remaining 50% of the total marks allotted to the **even** semester.

e.g. If a student has 6 courses (papers), in the odd semester, each of 100 marks (IA+SEE), and she scores 64, 53, 72, 61, 76 and 64 in each of the courses (papers), then she has scored a total of 390 out of 600 (which is equivalent to 32.5/50 rounded to 33/50).

i.e. $64+53+72+61+76+64=390/600$ Reduced to $32.5/50 = 33/50$

3. Calculation of the SEE marks for each course (paper) in the Current (Even) Semester (the semester for which exams could not be held)

For each course (paper), the marks obtained by the student in SEE will be the sum of her IA in that paper in the current (even) semester and the Previous Semester Average Marks (PSA).

i.e. IA of even semester + PSA of odd semester = SEE Marks for the even semester for which exam could not be held.

Student has obtained IA Marks 20 /25 in one course (paper).

In this e.g., 20 (IA of even semester) + 33 (PSA) = SEE 53/75

**The marks will be shown as follows:
IA 20/25; SEE 53/75; Total 73/100**

Option B (FY and SY BMM): In the case where IA:SEE is 40:60 format

1. Current (Even) Semester Internal Assessment Marks (IA)

For any course (paper) the even semester IA marks out of 40 is to be scaled down to marks out of 10 and added to the Previous (Odd) Semester Average Marks (PSA).

e.g. Student has obtained the IA Marks 20/40. The 40 marks will be scaled down to 10 marks. So the student will get 5 marks out of 10.

The marks thus calculated will comprise a part of the SEE marks out of 60 allotted to the current even semester in a course (paper).

2. How to calculate Previous (Odd) Semester Average Marks (PSA)

The average of marks of all the subjects (theory and practical) obtained by a student in the previous **odd** semester will be considered. This will contribute to the remaining 50% of the total marks allotted to the **even** semester.

e.g. If a student has 6 courses (papers), in the odd semester, each of 100 marks, and scores 64, 53, 72, 61, 76 and 64 in each of the courses (paper), then she has scored a total of 390 out of 600 (which is equivalent to 32.5/50 rounded to 33/50).

i.e. $64+53+72+61+76+64=390/600$ Reduced to $32.5/50 = 33/50$

3. Calculation of the SEE marks for each course (paper) in the Current (Even) Semester

For each course (paper), the marks obtained by the student in SEE will be the sum of her IA in that paper and the Previous Semester Average Marks (PSA).

i.e. $IA/10$ of even semester + PSA of odd semester = SEE marks for the even semester in which exams could not be held.

In this e.g., it will be $5/10$ (IA) + $33/50$ (PSA) = SEE $38/60$.

**The marks will be shown as follows:
IA 20/40; SEE 38/60; Total 58/100.**

III. RULES REGARDING COURSES WHICH HAVE NOT BEEN CLEARED (ATKT)

A student, who does not pass in some of the courses (papers) under the above-mentioned marking system for the current (even) semester, will be allowed to appear for the **Special Even Semester** (ATKT) examination in the same course (paper) of the **even** semester. This examination is to be held within 120 days of the commencement of the regular college classes.

If the student still does not clear the above-mentioned exam for a course (paper), she will appear for the Additional ATKT End Semester (even) exam for that course (paper) at the end of the odd semester of the academic year 2020-21.

If a student has not cleared an **Internal Assessment** in any of the courses (papers), in the even semester (in which the exam could not be held), she will have to appear for an IA ATKT in that course within 120 days of the commencement of lectures.

IV. Improvement of Grade Exam

A student who has cleared all the courses (papers) and is not satisfied with the **grade** obtained as per the above-mentioned method, will be allowed to appear for the **Special Even Semester** (Improvement of Grade) examination of the even semester. This exam is to be held within 120 days of the commencement of the regular college classes. **The student will be required to surrender her marksheet and passing certificate of the even semester to appear for this exam (these marks will be considered null and**

void). The student will have to accept the grade obtained in the Special Even Semester (Improvement of Grade) examination as the final grade.
