PeerPal Interviews for Co-ordinators

The interviews for all the course coordinators were taken by the PeerPal Head between 13th July 2023 to 15th July 2023 online through a zoom meeting. The interviews were taken in slots of 2 people at a time. Amidst the process of interviews for course coordinators, forms for graphic designers were also circulated and a few extra questions were asked about the usage of respective apps and methods used for designing.

Based on the performance in the interviews, coordinators were chosen.

Interviews for cohort and assistant cohort leaders

Online registration forms were circulated for the interviews of cohort leaders and assistant cohort leaders for Peerpal. Walk-in interviews were also entertained. The interviews for cohort leaders and assistant cohort leaders were taken by the course coordinators in slots of 2. The interviews were taken in the span of 31^{st} July 2023 to 8th August 2023. Interviews were taken at the triangular terrace. A grade out of 10 scoring system was used for all the people who interviewed. Following are the questions asked to them –

- 1. What will you do if your cohort is being unresponsive?

- 2. Asst cohort leader is being unresponsive.
- 3. Asst cohort leader is struggling with duties.
- 4. Coordinator is unresponsive
- ➤ Roleplay ideas:
- 1. With the leader/asst and a shy member of the cohort.
- 2. With an unresponsive member
- 3. With another cohort leader with whom you were supposed to have a collab cohort event.
