Dr. Nilesh proposed for the title change of the paper - Decoding Childhood., as discussed in the previous BOS meeting.

The proposed Co-Curricular Course of the Department was an updated version of Changing Frames a two Credit Course organised by the department, titled Power of Perspective, with the aim of exposing students to handle themselves and their mental health better. Upper capacity of students limited to 45 students for the course, which was conducted online. There were 12 sessions, which were two hours long, followed by Q&A Sessions. Their learnings were assessed via a reflective report. Attendance/Feedback for all sessions was mandatory. Dr. Smita also proposed how Workplace Ethics and Discipline could be a theme addressed as part of Co-Curricular Course.

The Field project proposed was a 25-hour based volunteering work to be completed in any organization that involves work with children/individuals in need/environment, followed by a submission of report, curating their experience and work done with the organization. Dr. Smita recommended how common, relevant themes can be identified within the purview of Psychology, which can then be a framework for students to pursue their field work project.




